

WOULD YOU KNOW IF SOMEONE WAS HAVING A STROKE?

Recognising a stroke quickly can mean the difference between life and death or between a full recovery and lasting disability. FAST, a simple, four-letter acronym makes it easy to remember the signs that can save someone's life.

F - Face - Has their face fallen on

one side? Can they smile?

A – Arms - Can they raise both arms and keep them there?

S – Speech - Is their speech slurred?

T – Time to call 999 if you spot any of these signs. When you see any of these stroke warning signs, remember that minutes count. The average stroke destroys around 2 million brain cells every minute. Know the signs - Act FAST.
