THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY (Use an ordinary Rosary)



Make the Sign of the Cross. Pray an Our Father, Hail Mary and The Apostles' Creed. On the Our Father beads say:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary beads say: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Repeat for the five decades. Conclude by repeating this prayer 3 times: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. ₩
