Chalking the Door of the Home on **Epiphany**

An Epiphany tradition in parts of Europe is for people to write a special sign in chalk over their front door, as a reminder of the Magi that visited the baby Jesus. It's made

using the year split in two. with the initials of the names that are sometimes given to the Magi, Caspar, Melchior & Balthazar, in the middle. So 2022 is written as

20+C+M+B+22. The initials CMB also stand for the Latin

phrase. Christus mansionem benedicat 'May Christ bless the house'. The inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless the home & be with all those who dwell in it throughout the year.

Prayer as you chalk the lintel of vour front door

In the name of the Father, & of the Son, & of the Holy Spirit. Amen. God of light, bless our home. Make it a haven of rest for all in need of your warmth and care, and when we go out from this place, may we never lose sight of that Epiphany star. We mark our door with the symbols of the Magi. 20 + C + M + B + 22May all who enter throughout the year find love & light; for Christ has come to dwell in this home & in our hearts. Amen.




