St. John Mary Vianney, Cure d'Ars. 1786 - 1859, he had to contend with poverty, military service & his own shortcomings in order to become a priest. In 1817 he was sent to care for the people of Ars, a small, obscure French village The marvellous gift of the unlearned priest for seeing into the depths of the soul brought the world to Ars. From 1830 on. the cure averaged twelve to sixteen hours a day in the confessional. He is Patron of Priests.

The feast invites us to 'go up the mountain', to set aside time and space to listen to God's Word, as we are asked to do by the voice from the cloud.
